

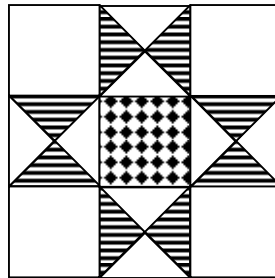
Cowbelle Patchwork

“Ohio Star”






(finished size 9½”)

(Seam allowance of ¼” used throughout)



Requirements :

-  Fabric One
Two 4¼” squares
Four 3½” squares
-  Fabric Two
One 3½” square
-  Fabric Three
Two 4¼” squares

Making Your Ohio Star Block :

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on the back of two Fabric Three 4¼” squares.
- 2) Pair these squares with the corresponding two 4¼” Fabric One squares, right sides together.
- 3) Sew ¼” either side of the pencil lines on both pairs.
- 4) Cut along pencil lines.
- 5) Open squares and press so the seam allowances are under the darker fabric.
- 6) Place two of these squares right sides together with each fabric on top of its opposite. Draw a diagonal line on one side of this pairing and sew ¼” either side of the line. Cut along the pencil line. Open and press. Repeat for the other pair of squares.
- 7) Join all your little blocks to produce the block illustrated above.
